Based on data provided by the 175 176 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 177 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 178 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 179 180 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 181 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2004 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 182 183 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 184 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2004 "Personal Services" 185 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 186 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 187 188 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 189 190 It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer 191 between the various offices authorized herein both funds and 192 positions not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the receiving 193 office in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in 194 195 accordance with Section 27-104-17 (3), Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of 196 Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the 197 198 transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of SS05\HB1552A.J
