- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. (1) Any person, firm or corporation who
- dismantles, crushes or otherwise destroys a motor vehicle shall 8
- 9 determine if any lien exists upon the motor vehicle and notify any
- lienholders by certified mail before dismantling, crushing or 10
- destroying such motor vehicle. A lienholder has seven (7) days 11
- after receipt of notice to claim a motor vehicle. A reasonable 12
- effort shall be made to identify and notify any lienholder. 13
- 14 (2) Any person, firm or corporation who violates the
- provisions of subsection (1) of this section, upon conviction, 15
- 16 shall be punished as follows:
- 17 (a) For a first offense by a fine of One Hundred
- Dollars (\$100.00) per occurrence; 18
- (b) For a second offense committed within three (3) 19
- years by a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per occurrence; 20
- 21 and
- 22 (c) For a third or subsequent offense committed within
- 23 three (3) years of a previous offense One Thousand Dollars
- (\$1,000.00) per occurrence, the revocation of any business license 24
- for one (1) year and by imprisonment for not more than six (6) 25
- months. 26
- 27 The State Tax Commission shall investigate and prosecute
- 28 violators of this section. The State Tax Commission may utilize

- 29 the assistance of any law enforcement agency to carry out the
- 30 provisions of this section. The tax assessors of the counties
- 31 shall assist the State Tax Commission in performing its duties
- 32 under this section.
- 33 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 34 and after July 1, 2004.

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
