HOUSE BILL NO. 1037

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-13-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO INCREASE THE FEES FOR MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTION CERTIFICATES;
3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-13-11, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6 amended as follows:

7 63-13-11. A fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) shall be charged for
8 an inspection and issuance of a certificate of inspection for
9 vehicles registered in this state. A fee of Twenty Dollars
10 (\$20.00) shall be charged for an inspection and issuance of a
11 certificate of inspection for vehicles registered in another state
12 unless a reciprocal agreement, as provided for in Section 63-13-7
13 has been approved, in which event no Mississippi certificate of
14 inspection shall be required. The fee for state registered
15 vehicles shall include a charge of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per
16 certificate of inspection, which shall be remitted to the
17 Mississippi Department of Public Safety. The fee for motor
18 vehicles registered in another state includes a charge of Nineteen
19 Dollars (\$19.00) per certificate of inspection, which shall be
20 remitted to the Department of Public Safety. The funds so
21 received by the department shall be deposited in the General Fund
22 of the State Treasury in accordance with the provisions of Section
23 45-1-23(2). The portion of the fee which is not remitted to the
24 department may be retained by the official inspection stations.

25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and
26 after July 1, 2004.
