HOUSE BILL NO. 1066

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-991, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ELIMINATE THE FOURTEEN-MONTH GAP BETWEEN ELECTION AND TAKING
- 3 OFFICE OF CERTAIN SUPREME COURT JUSTICES; AND FOR RELATED
- 4 PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-991, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 23-15-991. The term of office of judges of the Supreme Court
- 9 shall be eight (8) years. * * * An election shall be held on the
- 10 first Tuesday after the first Monday in November immediately
- 11 preceding the expiration of the term of an incumbent in the
- 12 Supreme Court district from which each incumbent was elected and
- 13 likewise each eighth year thereafter, at which there shall be
- 14 elected a successor to the incumbent, whose term of office shall
- 15 thereafter begin on the first Monday of January of the year in
- 16 which the term of the incumbent he succeeds expires.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 18 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 19 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 20 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 21 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 22 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 23 extended.
- 24 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 25 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 26 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
