- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Jackson State University shall establish and 5
- 6 administer a Judicial College to provide training and continuing
- 7 education for judges throughout the United States. The Judicial
- 8 College shall be located on the main campus of Jackson State
- 9 University. The Judicial College shall charge appropriate tuition
