5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be							
6	necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out							
7	of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available							
8	to the Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District, for the							
9	purpose of paying bond maturities, accrued interest, maintenance							
10	expenses, project development costs, and any other authorized							
11	expenses of the water management district, for the fiscal year							
12	beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005

- 62 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 63 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 64 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 66 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 67 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 68 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 69 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 70 Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District shall maintain
- 71 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 72 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 73 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 74 maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of
- 75 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 76 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 77 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 78 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request

- 80 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 81 agency shall provide a report reflecting Fiscal Year 2004 usage of
- 82 wireless communication devices which shall include cellular
- 83 phones, two-way radios, pagers, or any other means of wireless
- 84 communications to the Chairman of the House Appropriations
- 85 Committee, the Chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee,
- 86 and the State Auditor by September 1, 2004. The report shall
- 87 contain, but not be limited to, the following:
- 88 (1) The number of wireless communication devices provided to
- 89 employees by the agency;
- 90 (2) The annual cost of usage of wireless communication
- 91 devices by each employee of the agency who is issued a wireless
- 92 communication device;

- (4) To determine whether quantifiable benefits are 97 associated with the utilization of wireless communications and 98 whether such service provides more efficient or effective service 99 delivery.
- SECTION 5. All monies in possession of the district in 100 101 excess of necessary operating funds shall be deposited with a bank or banks selected by the board of directors of the district. 102
- 103 These funds shall be deposited in such bank or banks and in such 104 manner that interest earned shall be at least equal to interest 105 earnings on state funds deposited by the State Treasury.
- 106 SECTION 6. The money herein approved for expenditure shall 107 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 108 or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 109 110 and after July 1, 2004.
