| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 6 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State |
| 7 | Treasury to the credit of the Public Service Commission Regulation |
| 8 | Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi |
| 9 | Public Service Commission for the fiscal year beginning |
| 10 | July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005 |
| 11 | \$ 5,495,629.00. |
| 12 | SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions |
| 13 | of Section 1, the following positions are authorized: |
| 14 | AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: |
| 15 | Permanent: Full Time 69 |
| 16 | Part Time 1 |
| 17 | Time-Limited: Full Time 0 |
| 18 | Part Time 0 |
| 19 | With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of |
| 20 | the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to |
| 21 | make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal |
| 22 | Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005 |
| 23 | funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions |
| 24 | are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the |
| 25 | Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the |
| 26 | Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall |
| 27 | determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all |

28 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this

29 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure

- 30 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 31 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
- 32 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 33 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 34 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 35 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 36 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services"
- 37 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 38 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 39 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 40 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 41 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 42 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 43 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 44 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 45 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 46 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 48 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 49 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 54 **SECTION 3.** None of the funds herein appropriated by this act
- 55 to the Public Service Commission shall be expended for any purpose
- 56 that is not actually required or necessary for performing any of
- 57 the powers or duties of the Mississippi Public Service Commission
- 58 that are authorized by the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, state
- 59 or federal law, or rules or regulations that implement state or
- 60 federal law.

- 61 **SECTION 4.** The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund
- 62 all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions:
- (1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant
- 64 positions;
- 65 (2) The agency shall not take any action to promote or
- 66 otherwise award salary increases through reallocation,
- 67 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder,
- or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions
- 69 except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No.
- 70 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;
- 71 (3) The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state
- 72 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 73 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;
- 74 (4) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or
- 75 contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for
- 76 support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the
- 77 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology
- 78 Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 79 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;
- 80 (5) The agency shall not expend funds to publish or
- 81 distribute any annual reports or other publications;
- 82 (6) The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
- 83 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
- 84 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 85 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Legislative Session;
- 86 (7) The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
- 87 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
- 88 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry
- 89 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;
- 90 (8) The agency shall not expend funds for staff development
- 91 or training services;
- 92 (9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of
- 93 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease

| 97 | SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that none |
| 98 | of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members |
| 99 | of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate |
| 100 | are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony |
| 101 | announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public |
| 102 | announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening |
| 103 | of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has |
| 104 | made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or |
| 105 | any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following |
| 106 | language: "Funds were made available for this project by the |
| 107 | Mississippi State Legislature." |
| 108 | SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the |
| 109 | Public Service Commission shall maintain complete accounting and |
| 110 | personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds |
| 111 | appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the |
| 112 | same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year |
| 113 | 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the |
| 114 | agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to |
| 115 | the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of |
| 116 | detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided |
| 117 | during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. |
| 118 | SECTION 7. In addition to all other sums herein |
| 119 | appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 120 | necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury |
| 121 | to the credit of the Public Service Commission, for the purpose of |
| 122 | defraying the expenses of the Public Service Commission to |
| 123 | administer the Mississippi Telephone Solicitation Act, for the |
| 124 | fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005 |

| 129 | resources of the commission employed and used as law enforcement |
| 130 | personnel to the Department of Public Safety on July 1, 2004. The |
| 131 | transfer of personnel shall be commensurate with the number and |
| 132 | classification of positions allocated to that law enforcement. |
| 133 | The transfer also shall include direct support, clerical, data |
| 134 | processing and communications positions allocated to that |
| 135 | enforcement. |
| 136 | SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by |
| 137 | the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the |
| 138 | credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon |
| 139 | warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal |
| 140 | Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the |
| 141 | proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. |
