HOUSE BILL NO. 1744  
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER  
2 PARKWAY COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF  
3 THE COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2005.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi River  
8 Parkway Commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of  
9 the commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and  
10 ending June 30, 2005..... \$ 25,488.00.

11 **SECTION 2.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
13 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi River Parkway Commission  
14 which is comprised of special source funds collected by or  
15 otherwise available to the commission, for the purpose of  
16 defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal year  
17 beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005.....  
18 ..... \$ 13,762.00.

19 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the  
20 Mississippi River Parkway Commission shall maintain complete  
21 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all  
22 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be  
23 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal  
24 Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that  
25 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be  
26 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format

27 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail  
28 provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process.

29       **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by  
30 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the  
31 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon  
32 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal  
33 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the  
34 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

35       **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
36 and after July 1, 2004.
