- 14 state playoffs this year, winning the JCJC 7-on-7 Championship,
- 15 the District 7-2A Championship and the 2A South State
- 16 Championship, in addition to the overall Class 2A State
- 17 Championship and finishing the season ranked No. 1 in the State of
- 18 Mississippi by The Clarion Ledger for Division 2A teams; and
- 19 WHEREAS, many individual honors have been bestowed upon
- 20 various team members in recognition of their fine, dedicated play
- 21 this season, including Jacob Turner receiving the titles of All-
- 22 State Defensive Player of the Year and District 7-2A Defensive
- 23 Most Valuable Player, the naming of Brandon Hopstein and Tim
- 24 Holloway to the 1st Team All-State, Mike Watts and Derwin Cooley
- 25 to the 2nd Team All-State, and the selection of Brandon Hopstein,
- 26 Tim Holloway, Mike Watts, Matthew Mauldin, Marcus Duplessy, Kyle
- 27 Sullivan and Brandon Hicks to the 1st Team All-District; and

- WHEREAS, the Bulldogs have been superbly coached and inspired
- 29 by Head Coach Lance Mancuso and Assistant Coaches Eddie Lofton,
- 30 Chris Peden and Brian Rials, who have broadened the Bulldogs'
- 31 knowledge of the game and refined their skills in execution; and
- 32 WHEREAS, Coach Mancuso has brought additional honor to
- 33 himself and to Seminary High School by being selected as Area
- 34 Coach of the Year, Mississippi High School Activities Association
- 35 Coach of the Year for Class 2A, Hattiesburg American Coach of the
- 36 Year and WDAM Coach of the Year; and
- WHEREAS, having forced three shutouts, scoring 542 points and
- 38 allowing only 164 points this season, the Bulldogs have developed
- 39 a winning and cooperative spirit and a high degree of
- 40 sportsmanship, and their activities and attitude reflect great

- 42 honor to Seminary High School; and
