- 4 WHEREAS, the yellow and red flag evolves from 40 A.D. when
- 5 two sisters used a yellow banner to lead a revolt against Chinese
- 6 occupiers and the red stripes have been added over the last two
- 7 centuries; and
- 8 WHEREAS, when South Vietnam fell to communist North Vietnam
- 9 in 1975, the unified nation's new flag became a red banner with a
- 10 gold star; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Biloxi City Council unanimously approved a
- 12 resolution recognizing the yellow and red flag as the official
- 13 symbol for the city's Vietnamese-American community; and
- 14 WHEREAS, many immigrants of Vietnam have made a new life on
- 15 the Mississippi Gulf Coast; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the flag has been endorsed by American veterans who
- 17 fought in Vietnam; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Biloxi's recognition of the yellow and red flag
- 19 follows the example of cities in California and Washington that
- 20 have passed similar resolutions; and
- 21 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
- 22 recognize progressive cities such as Biloxi in their pursuit to
- 23 recognize the history of its citizens:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
- 25 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby
- 26 commend the Biloxi City Council for its unanimous approval to
