## SENATE BILL NO. 2115

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-3-42, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 AUTHORIZE BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS TO MAINTAIN PRIVATE ROADS OR 2 3 DRIVEWAYS USED AS TURNAROUNDS BY HEAD START BUSES; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 19-3-42, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 19-3-42. (1) The board of supervisors of any county is 8 9 hereby authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to grade, 10 gravel or shell, repair, and/or maintain private gravel or shell roads or driveways to private residences if such roads or 11 driveways are used for school bus turnarounds, including Head 12 Start program buses or any successor to that program. 13 (2) Prior to engaging in the work authorized in subsection 14 (1) of this section, the board of supervisors shall spread upon 15 the official minutes of the board: 16 17 (a) The written request of the school board or local Head Start administrator for such work; 18 19 (b) The written approval of the board of supervisors for such work; 20 21 The specific location of the road or driveway to be (C) worked; and 22 23 (d) The name of the owner of the road or driveway to be 24 worked. The written request of the school board or local Head 25 (3) 26 Start administrator, as required in subsection (2)(a) above, shall contain a current list of all active \* \* \* bus turnarounds 27 presently in use \* \* \* or contemplated for use \* \* \* for the 28 \*SS01/R251\* S. 29 present school year. The approval by the board of supervisors 30 shall be valid and effective for the period of time that a 31 turnaround is anticipated for use, but <u>not</u> for a period greater 32 than one (1) year.

33 (4) \* \* \* The board of supervisors of any county is further 34 authorized, in its discretion, to maintain public school grounds 35 of the county and to grade, gravel, shell or overlay, and/or to maintain gravel, shell, asphalt or concrete roads, driveways or 36 parking lots of public schools of the county if, before engaging 37 38 in the work, the board of supervisors shall spread upon its 39 official minutes the written request of the school board for the work, the written approval of the board of supervisors for the 40 work and the specific location of the school grounds or road, 41 42 driveway or parking lot, to be worked.

(5) \* \* \* The board of supervisors of any county is hereby 43 authorized, in its discretion, to repair and maintain driveways 44 45 and parking lots of: (a) any nonprofit organization in the county which is tax exempt under Section 501(c) of the United States 46 Internal Revenue Code and which has as one of its primary purposes 47 48 for organization to aid and assist in the rehabilitation of 49 persons suffering from drug abuse or drug addiction; and (b) any private, nonprofit cemeteries in the county. The board of 50 supervisors of any county shall not be authorized under the 51 52 provisions of this subsection to repair or maintain driveways or 53 parking lots located more than one hundred fifty (150) feet from 54 the center of any highway, road or street under the jurisdiction 55 of the county.

56 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 57 and after its passage.

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
