## SENATE BILL NO. 2126

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE HEALTH CARE 2 EXPENDABLE FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION 3 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING FOR SUPPLEMENTAL HEALTH INSURANCE FOR 4 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS EMPLOYED BY THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI WHO 5 DESIRE TO PARTICIPATE IN AN OPTIONAL SUPPLEMENTAL HEALTH INSURANCE 6 PROGRAM, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Health 9 10 Care Expendable Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration for the purpose of paying for 11 supplemental health insurance for highway patrolmen, conservation 12 officers and any other law enforcement officers employed by the 13 State of Mississippi, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, 14 and ending June 30, 2005.....\$1,000,000.00. 15

SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 16 17 Insurance Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall establish guidelines for the allocation of funds 18 appropriated in Section 1 of this act for those law enforcement 19 20 officers employed by the State of Mississippi who choose to participate in any optional supplemental health insurance program 21 22 offered with the approval of the Insurance Division of the Department of Finance and Administration. 23

24 **SECTION 3.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 25 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 26 27 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 28 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 29 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. \*SS01/R235\* S.
