The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 8 9 Treasury to the credit of the Tobacco Litigation Health Care Expendable Fund not otherwise appropriated to the Office of the 10 Attorney General for the purpose of providing funds to support the 11 Boys and Girls Clubs of America located in the State of 12 13 Mississippi, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and 14 ending June 30, 2005..... \$2,500,000.00. SECTION 2. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 15 16 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal 17 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants 18 19 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers 20 in the manner provided by law. 21 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
