## SENATE BILL NO. 2312

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-29-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CREATE THE FELONY OF DESECRATION OF A HUMAN CORPSE; AND FOR 1 2 3 RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. Section 97-29-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6

7 97-29-25. (1) (a) Every person who shall knowingly and 8 willfully dig up, except as otherwise provided by law, obliterate, or in any way desecrate any cemetery where human dead are 9 interred, or cause through word, deed or action the same to 10 happen, shall upon conviction be imprisoned for not more than one 11 12 (1) year in the county jail or fined not more than Five Hundred 13 Dollars (\$500.00), or both, in the discretion of the court. In addition to any penalties that the court is otherwise authorized 14 15 to impose the court may, in its discretion, order such restitution as it deems appropriate. 16

In construing this subsection (1), a cemetery shall 17 (b) 18 mean any plot of ground (i) on which are grave markers of stone, 19 wood, metal or any other material recognizable as marking graves, 20 or (ii) the boundaries of which are defined by a recorded plat, a 21 fence line or corner markers, or trees, or are defined in any other discernible manner. 22

(2) Every person who shall knowingly and willfully dig up, 23 except as otherwise provided by law, or in any way desecrate any 24 corpse or remains of any human being, or cause through word, deed 25 26 or action the same to happen, shall upon conviction be guilty of a felony and shall be imprisoned for not more than three (3) years 27

28 or fined not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or both,

29 <u>in the discretion of the court.</u>

30 **SECTION 2**. This act shall take effect and be in force from 31 and after July 1, 2004.
