- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 19-19-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 19-19-7. It shall be the duty of the constable to * * * obey
- 8 all lawful orders of the justice courts of his district and to
- 9 execute all judgments of the justice courts in any criminal case
- 10 before them.
- 11 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 12 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 13 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 14 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 15 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 16 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 17 extended.
- 18 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 20 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
