- 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) No all-terrain vehicle shall be operated by
- any person unless: 8
- 9 (i) He possesses a valid driver's license; or

- No person under sixteen (16) years of age may 12
- 13 operate or ride upon any all-terrain vehicle upon any public or
