1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-1-705, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ABOLISH THE MULTI-MODAL FUND COMMITTEE AND TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE PORT MULTI-MODAL FUND COMMITTEE; TO AMEND SECTION 65-1-707, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DELETE THE 5% DISCRETIONARY DISTRIBUTION OF MULTI-MODAL FUNDS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; TO DELETE DISCRETIONARY MULTIYEAR COMMITMENT TO FUNDING; TO AMEND SECTION 65-1-709, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE MULTI-MODAL FUND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE; TO REPEAL SECTION 65-1-711, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE REPEAL OF THE MULTI-MODAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
13	SECTION 1. Section 65-1-705, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
14	amended as follows:
15	65-1-705. * * *
16	(1) (a) There is hereby created the Port Multi-Modal Fund
17	Committee whose membership shall consist of:
18	(i) Six (6) directors of * * * ports, appointed by
19	the President of the Mississippi Water Resources Association, or
20	their designees, as follows: three (3) directors of the coastal
21	ports and three (3) directors of the inland river ports;
22	(ii) The Executive Director of MDA, or his
23	designee;
24	(iii) The Executive Director of MDOT, or his
25	designee; and
26	(iv) The Executive Director of the Mississippi
27	Water Resources Association, or his designee.

(b) A majority of the membership of the committee shall

constitute a quorum. MDOT shall call meetings of the committee

and shall call a meeting for the purpose of reviewing and

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- 31 approving applications as required in Section 65-1-707 by not
- 32 later than August 1 of each fiscal year.
- 33 (2) (a) There is hereby created an Airport Multi-Modal Fund
- 34 Committee whose membership shall consist of:
- 35 (i) Five (5) directors of airports appointed by
- 36 the President of the Mississippi Airport Association, or their
- 37 designees, at least three (3) of whom shall represent airports
- 38 with commercial passenger service;
- 39 (ii) The Executive Director of MDA, or his
- 40 designee; and
- 41 (iii) The Executive Director of MDOT, or his
- 42 designee.
- 43 (b) A majority of the membership of the committee shall
- 44 constitute a quorum. MDOT shall call meetings of the committee
- 45 and shall call a meeting for the purpose of reviewing and
- 46 approving applications as required in Section 65-1-707 by not
- 47 later than August 1 of each fiscal year.
- 48 (3) (a) There is hereby created the Railroad Multi-Modal
- 49 Fund Committee whose membership shall consist of:
- 50 (i) The director of each railroad, or his
- 51 designee;
- 52 (ii) The Executive Director of MDA, or his
- 53 designee; and
- 54 (iii) The Executive Director of MDOT, or his
- 55 designee.
- 56 (b) A majority of the membership of the committee shall
- 57 constitute a quorum. MDOT shall call meetings of the committee
- 58 and shall call a meeting for the purpose of reviewing and
- 59 approving applications as required in Section 65-1-707 by not
- 60 later than August 1 of each fiscal year.
- 61 (4) (a) There is hereby created the Public Transit
- 62 Multi-Modal Fund Committee whose membership shall consist of:

- Three (3) directors of transit systems, other 63 (i)
- 64 than the Coast Transit Authority and the City of Jackson Transit
- 65 System serving the greater Jackson urbanized area, appointed by
- 66 the President of the Mississippi Public Transit Association, or
- 67 their designees;
- 68 (ii) The Executive Director of MDA, or his
- 69 designee; and
- 70 (iii) The Executive Director of MDOT, or his
- designee. 71
- A majority of the membership of the committee shall 72
- 73 constitute a quorum. MDOT shall call meetings of the committee
- and shall call a meeting for the purpose of reviewing and 74
- 75 approving applications as required in Section 65-1-707 by not
- later than August 1 of each fiscal year. 76
- 77 SECTION 2. Section 65-1-707, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 78 amended as follows:
- 79 65-1-707. (1) During each state fiscal year, MDOT shall
- 80 distribute \* \* \* the money in the fund among the various modes as
- follows: 81
- 82 Thirty-eight percent (38%) shall be distributed to (a)
- 83 ports;
- 84 (b) Thirty-four percent (34%) shall be distributed to
- 85 airports;
- 86 (C) Sixteen percent (16%) shall be distributed to
- 87 transit systems; and
- (d) Twelve percent (12%) shall be distributed to 88
- 89 railroads.

- In order for a port to receive money allocated under 91 (2)
- subsection (1) of this section, the port shall file an application 92
- 93 with MDOT describing how the funds will be used and shall provide
- 94 such other information as MDOT may require. Such applications
- shall be reviewed by the Port Multi-Modal Fund Committee. 95

- 96 Port Multi-Modal Fund Committee shall decide which applications
- 97 shall be approved and the amount of funding for each approved
- 98 application based upon such criteria as it shall consider
- 99 appropriate; provided, however, that no application shall be
- 100 approved or funds distributed pursuant to this article unless the
- 101 expenditure of such funds shall be:
- 102 (a) Directly related to dredging, capital improvements
- 103 or the rebuilding or rehabilitation of basic infrastructure and
- 104 not for routine maintenance, administrative or operational
- 105 expenses;
- 106 (b) For a project or use directly related to the
- 107 operation of the port in its modal role; and
- 108 (c) For a purpose outside the normal operating budget
- 109 of the port.
- 110 (3) In order for an airport to receive money allocated under
- 111 subsection (1) of this section, the airport shall file an
- 112 application with MDOT describing how the funds will be used and
- 113 shall provide such other information as MDOT may require. Such
- 114 applications shall be reviewed by the Airport Multi-Modal Fund
- 115 Committee. The Airport Multi-Modal Fund Committee shall decide
- 116 which applications shall be approved and the amount of funding for
- 117 each approved application based upon such criteria as it shall
- 118 consider appropriate; provided, however, that no application shall
- 119 be approved or funds distributed pursuant to this article unless
- 120 the expenditure of such funds shall be:
- 121 (a) Directly related to capital improvements or the
- 122 rebuilding or rehabilitation of basic infrastructure and not for
- 123 routine maintenance, administrative or operational expenses;
- (b) For a project or use directly related to the
- 125 operation of the airport in its modal role; and
- 126 (c) For a purpose outside the normal operating budget
- 127 of the airport.

- 128 (4) In order for a railroad to receive money allocated under 129 subsection (1) of this section, the railroad shall file an 130 application with MDOT describing how the funds will be used and 131 shall provide such other information as MDOT may require. 132 applications shall be reviewed by the Railroad Multi-Modal Fund Committee. The Railroad Multi-Modal Fund Committee shall decide 133 which applications shall be approved and the amount of funding for 134 each approved application based upon such criteria as it shall 135 136 consider appropriate; provided, however, that no application shall be approved or funds distributed pursuant to this article unless 137
- (a) Directly related to capital improvements or the 139 140 rebuilding or rehabilitation of basic infrastructure and not for routine maintenance, administrative or operational expenses; 141
- (b) For a project or use directly related to the 142 operation of the railroad in its modal role; and 143

the expenditure of such funds shall be:

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- 144 (c) For a purpose outside the normal operating budget 145 of the railroad.
- (5) (a) Thirty percent (30%) of the money allocated for 146 147 transit systems under subsection (1) of this section shall be distributed by MDOT to Coast Transit Authority. 148
- 149 (b) Thirty percent (30%) of the money allocated for 150 transit systems under subsection (1) of this section shall be distributed by MDOT to the City of Jackson Transit System serving 151 152 the greater Jackson urbanized area.
- The remainder of the money allocated for transit 153 (C) 154 systems under subsection (1) of this section shall be distributed 155 by MDOT among other transit systems. In order to receive funds under subsection (1) of this section, any such transit system 156 157 shall file an application with MDOT describing how the money will 158 be used and shall provide such other information as MDOT may 159 require. Such applications shall be reviewed by the Public 160 Transit Multi-Modal Fund Committee. The Public Transit

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- 161 Multi-Modal Fund Committee shall decide which applications shall
- 162 be approved and the amount of funding for each approved
- 163 application based upon such criteria as it shall consider
- 164 appropriate.
- 165 (6) As a condition for the receipt of any funds distributed
- 166 under this section, the port, airport, railroad or transit system
- 167 shall be required to fund, from public or private sources, not
- 168 more than ten percent (10%) of the total cost of the project or
- 169 purpose for which the funds are to be spent. The percentage
- 170 amount of such matching fund requirement shall be determined by
- 171 MDOT. In addition to such other contributions and expenditures as
- 172 may be considered acceptable by MDOT, in-kind contributions and
- 173 expenditures for the following shall be credited toward the above
- 174 matching requirement:
- 175 (a) Pre-construction studies, planning and design;
- 176 (b) Personal property acquisition;
- 177 (c) Real property acquisition, reclamation and related
- 178 relocation costs;
- 179 (d) Professional services; and
- 180 (e) Construction.
- 181 (7) In addition to such other expenditures as may be deemed
- 182 appropriate by MDOT or hereunder, money distributed from the fund
- 183 may be used to meet federal matching fund requirements and for
- 184 pre-construction studies, planning and design; personal property
- 185 acquisition; real property acquisition, reclamation and related
- 186 relocation costs; professional services; and construction.

- SECTION 3. Section 65-1-709, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 189 amended as follows:
- 190 65-1-709. (1) There is hereby created the Joint Legislative
- 191 Multi-Modal Fund Committee which shall consist of \* \* \* the
- 192 Chairman of the Senate Highways and Transportation Committee, or
- 193 his designee; the Chairman of the Senate Ports and Marine

- 194 Resources Committee, or his designee; \* \* \* the Chairman of the
- 195 House Transportation Committee, or his designee; and the Chairman
- 196 of the House Ports, Harbors and Airports Committee, or his
- 197 designee \* \* \*. Administration of this article shall be subject
- 198 to oversight by the Joint Legislative Multi-Modal Fund Committee.
- 199 (2) MDOT shall annually prepare at its expense a written
- 200 report on administration of the fund \* \* \* which shall include,
- 201 without limitation, a description of all applications for funding
- 202 received under this article, the status of each application, the
- 203 criteria used to evaluate such application, and an analysis of the
- 204 return and benefits from funding projects under this
- 205 article \* \* \*. MDOT shall consult with the committees established
- 206 in Section 65-1-705 when preparing such report and provide
- 207 sufficient copies of the report at no cost to such committees.
- 208 MDOT shall submit such report to the Joint Legislative Multi-Modal
- 209 Fund Committee by not later than September 1 of each year.
- 210 **SECTION 4.** Section 65-1-711, which provides for the repeal
- of Sections 65-1-701 through 65-1-709 establishing the Multi-Modal
- 212 Transportation Improvement Program, is hereby repealed.
- 213 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 214 and after July 1, 2004.
