## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3127

## TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	Treasury to the credit of the State Personnel Board for the
7	support and maintenance of the State Personnel Board for the
8	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005
9	\$ 4,846,640.00.
10	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
11	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
12	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
13	Permanent: Full Time 62
14	Part Time 2
15	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
16	Part Time 0
17	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
18	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
19	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
20	Services" for Fiscal Year 2006 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2005
21	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
22	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2006 budget by the
23	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
24	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
25	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
26	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
27	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
28	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
29	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2005 appropriation for "Personal
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- 30 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 31 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 32
- 33 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2005 "Personal Services" 34
- 35 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 36 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 37 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 38 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 39
- 40 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 41
- Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 42
- approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 43 The
- 44 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 45 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 46
- 47 appropriated level.
- 48 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 49 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 50 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 51 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 52 SECTION 3. The funds authorized herein shall be used to fund
- 53 all operations of the agency with the following prohibitions:
- 54 (1) The agency shall not fill any current or future vacant
- 55 positions;
- The agency shall not take any action to promote or 56 (2)
- otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, 57
- 58 reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder,
- 59 or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions
- except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House Bill No. 60
- 61 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- The agency shall not expend funds for out-of-state 62
- 63 travel except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session; 64

65 The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of or

contract for cellular phones, two-way radios or pagers, except for 66

- support of employees in the Department of Public Safety and the 67
- 68 Bureau of Narcotics as recommended by Information Technology
- Services or as allowed under the provisions set forth in House 69
- 70 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 71 The agency shall not expend funds to publish or (5)
- 72 distribute any annual reports or other publications;
- 73 The agency shall not expend funds for public relation
- 74 activities regarding the functions, programs or services of the
- 75 agency except as allowed under the provisions set forth in House
- 76 Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session;
- 77 The agency shall not advertise the functions, programs
- 78 or services of the agency except that the Mississippi Development
- 79 Authority is authorized to expend funds for advertising to carry
- 80 out the purposes of key programs administered by the authority;
- The agency shall not expend funds for staff development 81
- 82 or training services;
- 83 (9) The agency shall not expend funds for the purchase of
- 84 new or replacement equipment or furniture, excluding lease
- 85 purchase payments on agreements in effect upon passage of this
- 86 appropriation bill, except as allowed under the provisions set
- 87 forth in House Bill No. 1279, 2004 Regular Session.
- 88 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that none
- 89 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members
- of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate 90
- are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 91
- announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 92
- 93 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening
- 94 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has
- made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 95
- 96 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following
- 97 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the
- 98 Mississippi State Legislature."

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Personnel Board shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2004. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2006 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2005 budget request process. 

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Personnel Board shall have the authority to escalate and expend funds received from state agencies for reimbursement of costs associated with the hiring of court reporters used in the Employee Appeals Process. Such funds shall be received and expended under the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer, and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from
