24 receive the highest number of votes."

25 **AMEND FURTHER** by striking the title in its entirety and  
26 inserting the following in lieu thereof:

27 "A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING TO AMEND SECTIONS 140 AND  
28 141 OF THE MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890 TO PROVIDE THAT THE  
29 PERSON RECEIVING A MAJORITY OF THE POPULAR VOTES CAST IN THE  
30 GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE OFFICE OF GOVERNOR SHALL BE DECLARED  
31 ELECTED; TO PROVIDE THAT IF NO CANDIDATE RECEIVES A MAJORITY, THE  
32 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES WILL DECIDE THE WINNER FROM THE TWO  
33 CANDIDATES WHO RECEIVE THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES; TO ABOLISH THE  
34 REQUIREMENT THAT THE GOVERNOR BE ELECTED BY VOTE OF THE HOUSE OF  
35 REPRESENTATIVES IF NO CANDIDATE RECEIVES BOTH A MAJORITY OF THE  
36 POPULAR VOTE AND A MAJORITY OF THE ELECTORAL VOTES; AND FOR  
37 RELATED PURPOSES."
