## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 11

1       A RESOLUTION COMMENDING L. KENDALL MCKENZIE, M.D., UPON  
2 COMPLETING HIS TOUR OF DUTY IN IRAQ SERVING AS A BATTALION  
3 SURGEON.

4       WHEREAS, L. Kendall McKenzie, M.D., recently completed his  
5 tour of duty as a Battalion Surgeon in the 3rd Battalion 124th  
6 Infantry of the Florida Army National Guard; and

7       WHEREAS, L. Kendall McKenzie was activated January 2, 2003,  
8 and was on active duty for 365 days; and

9       WHEREAS, L. Kendall McKenzie was stationed in Baghdad for his  
10 tour of duty and is ranked Captain; and

11       WHEREAS, L. Kendall McKenzie will be graduating from his  
12 Emergency Medicine Residency on June 19, 2004, at which time he  
13 will become a full-time faculty member in the Department of  
14 Emergency Medicine at the University of Mississippi Medical  
15 Center; and

16       WHEREAS, L. Kendall McKenzie will serve as the Director of  
17 Research and Development for the TeleEmergency Program and also as  
18 the Assistant Residency Director at the University of Mississippi  
19 Medical Center; and

20       WHEREAS, the Mississippi Legislature finds it most  
21 appropriate to recognize and commend the diligence of this veteran  
22 of Operation Iraqi Freedom for his devotion to duty and to his  
23 state and nation to secure and insure peace for all:

24       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF  
25 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend L. Kendall McKenzie, M.D.,  
26 upon completing his tour of duty in Iraq serving as a Battalion
