- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** In addition to the curriculum otherwise required
- 5 by law or the State Board of Education to be taught in the public
- 6 schools of this state, each student enrolled in the secondary
- 7 public schools shall be required to participate in not less than
- 8 three (3) class periods of physical education each week. However,
- 9 if a student is excused by a medical doctor for reasons hazardous
- 10 to the health of the student, then that student is exempt from the
- 11 requirement of this section. Students participating in varsity
- 12 athletics, marching band, cheerleading or any other physical
- 13 activity as determined by the board of education are exempt from
- 14 the requirement of this section.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this act shall be codified as a
- 16 separate code section in Chapter 13, Title 37, Mississippi Code of
- 17 1972.
