HOUSE BILL NO. 1085

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9-5-36, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL CHANCELLOR FOR THE TENTH CHANCERY COURT DISTRICT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 9-5-36, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 9-5-36. (1) There shall be four (4) chancellors for the
- 8 Tenth Chancery Court District.
- 9 (2) For purposes of appointment and election, the three (3)
- 10 chancellorships shall be separate and distinct and denominated for
- 11 purposes of appointment and election only as "Place One," "Place
- 12 Two $_{\underline{\mbox{\scriptsize '}}}$ " and "Place Three," and "Place Four," respectively. The
- 13 chancellor to fill Place One shall be a resident of Forrest,
- 14 Lamar, Marion, Pearl River or Perry County. The chancellor to
- 15 fill Place Two shall be a resident of Lamar, Marion, Pearl River
- 16 or Perry County. The chancellor to fill Place Three shall be a
- 17 resident of Forrest County. The chancellor to fill Place Four
- 18 shall be a resident of Forrest, Lamar, Marion, Pearl River or
- 19 Perry County. Election of the three (3) offices of chancellor
- 20 shall be by election to be held in every county within the Tenth
- 21 Chancery Court District of Mississippi.
- 22 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 23 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 24 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 25 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 26 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the

- 27 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 28 extended.
- 29 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 30 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 31 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
