- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi 6
- Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the 7
- 8 state:
- 9 Amend Section 202, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read
- 10 as follows:
- "Section 202. (1) Until the commencement of the term of 11
- office of the State Superintendent of Public Education elected at 12
- the general election in 2007, there shall be a State 13
- Superintendent of Public Education who shall be appointed by the 14
- State Board of Education, with the advice and consent of the 15
- Senate, and serve at the board's will and pleasure. 16
- Beginning at the general election in 2007, there shall 17
- be a State Superintendent of Public Education elected at the same 18
- time and manner as the Governor, who shall hold the office for a 19
- term of four (4) years, and until a successor is elected and 20
- 21 qualified. The first term of office of the elected State
- Superintendent of Public Education shall commence in January 2008. 22
- 23 (3) The State Superintendent of Public Education shall
- possess such qualifications as may be prescribed by law. 24
- State Superintendent shall be the chief administrative officer for 25
- 26 the State Department of Education and shall administer the
- department in accordance with the policies established by the 2.7

- 29 such other duties and receive such compensation as shall be
- 30 prescribed by law."
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be 31
- 32 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at
- 33 an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday
- 34 of November 2006, as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution
- 35 and by general law.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed 36
- amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: 37 "This proposed
- constitutional amendment changes the manner in which the State 38
- 39 Superintendent of Public Education is selected.
- amendment provides that the State Superintendent of Public 40
- Education shall be elected at the general state election held 41
- every four years, beginning in 2007, rather than appointed by the 42
- State Board of Education." 43
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Attorney General of the 44
- 45 State of Mississippi shall submit this resolution, immediately
- upon adoption by the Legislature, to the Attorney General of the 46
- United States or to the United States District Court for the 47
- 48 District of Columbia in accordance with the provisions of the
- Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended. 49
