## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 87

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE  
 2 PURPOSE OF THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF HOUSE BILL  
 3 1718, REGULAR SESSION OF 2005, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO CREATE A STUDY  
 4 COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE TAX SYSTEM OF THIS STATE AND TO MAKE  
 5 RECOMMENDATIONS THEREON TO THE LEGISLATURE; TO REQUIRE THE BUDGET  
 6 OF STATE AGENCIES BE REDUCED BY 5% IN FISCAL YEAR 2006; TO AMEND  
 7 SECTION 27-7-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE TAX

 45 PROCEDURE TO THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER FOR AGENCIES SEEKING TO TAKE  
 46 ANY ACTION THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE PROHIBITED BY THIS ACT; TO SET  
 47 FORTH THE DEMONSTRATION OF THE EMERGENCY THAT MUST BE MADE BY THE  
 48 AGENCY IN ITS APPEAL; TO PROVIDE THAT THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET  
 49 COMMITTEE SHALL BE NOTIFIED OF SUCH AN APPEAL AND THAT COMMITTEE  
 50 MEMBERS MAY ATTEND THE HEARING ON SUCH AN APPEAL; TO ALLOW THE  
 51 STATE FISCAL OFFICER, IN HIS DISCRETION, TO AUTHORIZE THE ACTION
