HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 94

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING S.C.
2 PERKINS, JR., UPON BEING NAMED MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF
3 TRANSPORTATION NORTHERN DISTRICT'S 2005 MISSISSIPPI LITTER LAWMAN
4 OF THE YEAR.

5 WHEREAS, Officer S.C. Perkins, Jr., the son of S.C. Perkins,
6 Sr., and the late Doshua Mae Perkins, born September 20, 1947, in
7 Leflore County, Mississippi, was recently named the Mississippi
8 Department of Transportation (MDOT) Northern District 2005
9 Mississippi Litter Lawman of the Year, having issued 104
10 citations; and

11 WHEREAS, Officer Perkins was presented this honor by MDOT and
12 the Keep Mississippi Beautiful Foundation at the February 22,
13 2005, MDOT/KMB Law Enforcement Luncheon held at the Mississippi
14 Agricultural and Forestry Museum; and

15 WHEREAS, the eldest of eight children, Officer Perkins, who
16 is a 1970 graduate of Amanda Elzy High School and a Mississippi
17 Valley State University Alumnus holding a bachelor's degree in
18 industrial arts; and

19 WHEREAS, a former employee and union leader at Baldwin Piano
20 and Organ Company, Officer Perkins has been employed with the
21 Greenwood Police Department as litter control officer since
22 January 13, 1989; and

23 WHEREAS, Officer Perkins is a member of the Providence
24 Missionary Baptist Church and has served as Pastor of Mitchell
25 Springs Missionary Baptist Church since 2000, enjoying the love,
26 support and encouragement of his wife, Dorothy, three daughters
27 and six grandchildren; and

28 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
29 and commend excellence in our state's law enforcement officers,
30 such as Officer Perkins, whose work as a keeper of the peace and
31 protector of our values is to be praised for his immeasurable
32 value to society:

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
34 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
35 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Officer S.C.
36 Perkins, Jr., upon being named MDOT Northern District 2005
37 Mississippi Litter Lawman of the Year.
