HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 96

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
2 PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING, AND THE INTRODUCTION,
3 CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE, OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND
4 SECTIONS 5-1-41, 5-1-43, 5-1-45, 5-1-46 AND 5-1-47, MISSISSIPPI
5 CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE,
6 INCLUDING THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF
7 THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE
8 SPEAKER PRO TEMPORE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, SHALL NOT BE
9 ENTITLED TO RECEIVE ANY COMPENSATION, EXPENSE ALLOWANCE, PER DIEM
10 OR MILEAGE ALLOWANCE FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING APRIL 4, 2005,
11 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2005, IF DURING SUCH PERIOD THE LEGISLATURE IS
12 CONVENED IN REGULAR OR EXTRAORDINARY SESSION; AND FOR RELATED
13 PURPOSES."

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE
15 OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That the Joint
16 Rules of the House and the Senate, including all the deadlines and
17 other provisions imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for
18 the purpose of requesting the drafting, and the introduction,
19 consideration and passage, of a bill entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND
20 SECTIONS 5-1-41, 5-1-43, 5-1-45, 5-1-46 AND 5-1-47, MISSISSIPPI
21 CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE,
22 INCLUDING THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF
23 THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE
24 SPEAKER PRO TEMPORE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, SHALL NOT BE
25 ENTITLED TO RECEIVE ANY COMPENSATION, EXPENSE ALLOWANCE, PER DIEM
26 OR MILEAGE ALLOWANCE FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING APRIL 4, 2005,
