HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 115

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
2 PURPOSE OF THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF HOUSE BILL
3 215, REGULAR SESSION OF 2005, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION
4 75-76-129, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REDISTRIBUTE A PORTION OF
5 THE STATE'S SHARE OF GAMING LICENSE FEES TO SPECIAL FUNDS, THE
6 PROCEEDS OF WHICH MAY BE USED FOR THE LOCAL SYSTEM BRIDGE
7 REPLACEMENT AND REHABILITATION PROGRAM AND THE LOCAL SYSTEM ROAD
8 PROGRAM; TO AMEND SECTION 65-37-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
9 DELETE THE PROVISIONS THAT REQUIRE THE LEGISLATURE TO APPROPRIATE
10 MONIES TO THE LOCAL SYSTEM BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND REHABILITATION
11 FUND; TO AMEND SECTIONS 65-18-9 AND 65-18-11, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
12 1972, TO CREATE THE LOCAL SYSTEM ROAD FUND; TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE
13 ENGINEER TO ALLOCATE MONIES IN THE FUND TO EACH COUNTY FOR
14 CONSTRUCTING, RECONSTRUCTING OF LOCAL SYSTEM ROADS; TO AMEND
15 SECTION 27-5-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DELETE THE
16 REQUIREMENT FOR THE PAYMENT OF A PORTION OF THE REVENUES DERIVED
17 FROM MOTOR FUEL TAXES TO BE DEPOSITED INTO THE GAMING COUNTIES
18 BOND SINKING FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE DEBT SERVICE ON
19 BONDS ISSUED IN SUPPORT OF THE GAMING COUNTIES INFRASTRUCTURE
20 PROGRAM; TO AMEND SECTION 75-76-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
21 REVISE THE DEFINITION OF THE TERM "LICENSE FEES" UNDER THE
22 MISSISSIPPI GAMING CONTROL ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE TERM INCLUDES
23 FEES REQUIRED FOR INVESTIGATION OF APPLICANTS FOR GAMING LICENSES;
24 TO AMEND SECTION 75-76-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE
25 THAT SUCH FEES SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AS OTHER FEES COLLECTED UNDER
26 THE MISSISSIPPI GAMING CONTROL ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

27 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE
28 OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That the Joint
29 Rules of the House and the Senate, including all deadlines and
30 other provisions imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for
31 the purpose of permitting the further consideration and passage of
32 House Bill No. 2005, Regular Session of 2005, entitled "AN ACT TO
33 AMEND SECTION 75-76-129, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REDISTRIBUTE
34 A PORTION OF THE STATE'S SHARE OF GAMING LICENSE FEES TO SPECIAL
35 FUNDS, THE PROCEEDS OF WHICH MAY BE USED FOR THE LOCAL SYSTEM
36 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND REHABILITATION PROGRAM AND THE LOCAL SYSTEM
37 ROAD PROGRAM; TO AMEND SECTION 65-37-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
38 TO DELETE THE PROVISIONS THAT REQUIRE THE LEGISLATURE TO
39 APPROPRIATE MONIES TO THE LOCAL SYSTEM BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND

46 REVENUES DERIVED FROM MOTOR FUEL TAXES TO BE DEPOSITED INTO THE
47 GAMING COUNTIES BOND SINKING FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE
48 DEBT SERVICE ON BONDS ISSUED IN SUPPORT OF THE GAMING COUNTIES
49 INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM; TO AMEND SECTION 75-76-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE
50 OF 1972, TO REVISE THE DEFINITION OF THE TERM "LICENSE FEES" UNDER
51 THE MISSISSIPPI GAMING CONTROL ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE TERM
52 INCLUDES FEES REQUIRED FOR INVESTIGATION OF APPLICANTS FOR GAMING
