COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2555

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-25-506, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
TO PROVIDE THAT THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2010, \$10,000,000.00 OF THE
STATE'S SHARE OF OIL AND GAS SEVERANCE TAXES SHALL BE DEPOSITED
INTO THE STATE GENERAL FUND AND THE REMAINDER SHALL BE
APPROPRIATED FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE MISSISSIPPI ADEQUATE EDUCATION
PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. Section 27-25-506, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 10 27-25-506. There is created a special fund in the State
- 11 Treasury into which the state's share of proceeds collected under
- 12 Sections 27-25-505 and 27-25-705 shall be deposited.
- The state's share of all oil and gas severance taxes derived
- 14 from oil and gas resources under state-owned lands or from severed
- 15 state-owned minerals shall be deposited into the State Treasury to
- 16 the credit of the trust fund created in Section 206A, Mississippi
- 17 Constitution of 1890. The following amounts of the remainder of
- 18 tax collections apportioned to the state shall be deposited to the
- 19 credit of the trust fund created in Section 206A, Mississippi
- 20 Constitution of 1890:

- 21 (a) For fiscal year 1994, all amounts collected in

- 25 (\$32,500,000.00);
- 26 (c) For fiscal year 1996, all amounts collected in
- 27 excess of Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00);

- 34 excess of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00);

- 37 (h) For fiscal year 2001 through December 31, 2000, all
- 38 amounts collected and transferred in excess of Ten Million Dollars
- 39 (\$10,000,000.00);
- 40 (i) For fiscal year 2005, all amounts collected in
- 41 excess of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00);
- 42 (j) For fiscal years 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009, all
- 43 amounts collected in excess of Ten Million Dollars
- 44 (\$10,000,000.00); and
- (k) For fiscal year 2010 and each fiscal year
- 46 thereafter, all such tax collections apportioned to the state
- 47 shall be deposited to the credit of the trust fund.
- The monies collected under paragraphs (a) through (j) of this
- 49 section that are not deposited into the trust fund shall be
- 50 deposited into the State General Fund. For fiscal years 2006,
- 51 2007, 2008 and 2009, the monies not deposited into the State
- 52 General Fund shall be deposited into the Budget Contingency Fund
- 53 created in Section 27-103-301. All monies deposited into the
- 54 Budget Contingency Fund under this section shall be appropriated
- 55 by the Legislature for the support of the Mississippi Adequate
- 56 Education Program as successor to the Minimum Education Program.
