- 30 (d) Provide assistance to state agencies in collecting
- 31 any invoiced amount or fee another agency has refused or failed to
- 32 pay. A state agency may request assistance and furnish the
- 33 Department of Finance and Administration with such complete and
- 34 detailed information as required. Upon determining the invoiced
- 35 amount or fee is proper and correct, the State Fiscal Officer
- 36 shall proceed to make the payment out of any funds in the State
- 37 Treasury to the credit of the delinquent agency. The State Fiscal
