SENATE BILL NO. 2689

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE PASCAGOULA RIVER  
2 IN GEORGE AND JACKSON COUNTIES AS A STATE SCENIC STREAM AND TO  
3 INCLUDE THE STREAM IN THE STATE SCENIC STREAMS STEWARDSHIP  
4 PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Pascagoula River from the confluence of the Leaf  
7 and Chickasawhay Rivers in George County to its mouth in Jackson  
8 County, which was designated as eligible for nomination under  
9 Section 51-4-17, is designated as a state scenic stream and is  
10 included in the Mississippi Scenic Streams Stewardship Program.

11 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
12 and after its passage
