SENATE BILL NO. 3045

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE  
2 MISSISSIPPI ETHICS COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
6 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of  
7 defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Ethics Commission for  
8 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006  
9 ..... \$ 519,050.00.

10 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of  
11 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be  
12 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of  
13 expenditure:

30           Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with  
31 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

32           No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be  
33 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are  
34 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this  
35 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

36           **SECTION 3.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by  
37 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the  
38 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon  
39 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal  
40 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the  
41 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

42           **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
43 and after July 1, 2005.
