SENATE BILL NO. 3116

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JOEL EDWARD GREGG
2 OF WEBSTER COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Joel Edward Gregg of Webster County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction of the crime of timber larceny, in 1980, in Webster
8 County, Mississippi, and who was sentenced to serve three (3)
9 years in the custody of the Department of Corrections. His
10 sentence was suspended and he was not placed on probation. Since
11 that time, he has conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable
12 citizen in a good and lawful manner.

13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
14 and after its passage.
