- Athletics and Boys Track and Field Coach at Pearl High School; and 6
- 7 WHEREAS, Coach Barnett, 51, started coaching cross-country
- and track at Pearl in 1977, and he has been selected Coach of the 8
- 9 Year by the Mississippi Association of Coaches seven times; and
- 10 WHEREAS, with 15 cross-country and 16 track championships,
- Woody Barnett was selected the 2004 National Federation of State 11
- High School Associations National Coach of the Year in the sport 12
- 13 of boys cross-country; and
- WHEREAS, Barnett was selected from the NFHS Region that 14
- includes Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, North 15
- 16 Carolina, South Carolina and Tennessee. He was then selected from
- the eight regions across the country; and 17
- WHEREAS, coaching has been a passion of Barnett for more than 18
- 19 34 years; and
- WHEREAS, under Coach Barnett's leadership, Pearl High School 20
- 21 has been in contention every year for the state title in both
- cross-country and track. The boys cross-country team won its 22
- 23 sixth consecutive state championship in 2004, and the girls won
- 24 their second straight. The boys team hasn't lost to a Mississippi
- school in 55 races; and 25
- 26 WHEREAS, "He is an outstanding coach and well deserving,"
- 2.7 former Pearl standout and now Assistant Coach George Kersh said,

- 28 "Coach Barnett does a good job of letting athletes know he cares
- 29 about them"; and
- 30 WHEREAS, persistence is how Barnett described his coaching
- 31 philosophy. His teams were not always the favorites going into
- 32 state meets, but they have dug deep to find heart, and that has
