SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 608

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
2 PURPOSE OF THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF THE FOLLOWING
3 BILLS: HOUSE BILL NO. 1000, 2005 REGULAR SESSION, ENTITLED "AN
4 ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 27-103-125, 27-103-139 AND 27-103-211,
5 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE PERCENTAGE LIMITATION ON
6 LEGISLATIVE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE STATE GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL
7 YEARS 2006 AND 2007; TO AMEND SECTION 27-65-75, MISSISSIPPI CODE
8 OF 1972, TO DELAY UNTIL 2007 THE SALES TAX DIVERSION THAT IS TO BE
9 DEPOSITED INTO THE SPECIAL FUNDS TRANSFER FUND; TO AMEND SECTION
10 4, CHAPTER 556, LAWS OF 2003, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 10, CHAPTER
11 595, LAWS OF 2004, TO CONFORM TO THE PRECEDING SECTION; TO AMEND
12 SECTION 27-25-506, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT
13 BEGINNING WITH FISCAL YEAR 2006, ALL AMOUNTS COLLECTED FROM
14 CERTAIN TAX COLLECTIONS APPORTIONED TO THE STATE FROM OIL AND GAS
15 SEVERANCE TAXES SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE STATE GENERAL FUND;
16 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."; SENATE BILL NO. 2845, 2005 REGULAR
17 SESSION, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO DIRECT THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER TO
18 TRANSFER CERTAIN SPECIAL FUNDS INTO THE BUDGET CONTINGENCY FUND
19 DURING FISCAL YEAR 2005; TO AMEND SECTION 4, CHAPTER 89, LAWS OF
20 2004, TO TRANSFER FUNDS IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2005 APPROPRIATION TO
21 THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AMONG VARIOUS CATEGORIES; AND FOR
22 RELATED PURPOSES."; AND HOUSE BILL NO. 693, 2005 REGULAR SESSION,
23 ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-104-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
24 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO
25 ASSIST A STATE AGENCY IN COLLECTING A FEE THAT ANOTHER STATE
26 AGENCY HAS FAILED TO PAY TO IT; TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE FISCAL
27 OFFICER TO PAY THE CREDITOR AGENCY THE AMOUNT OWED TO IT OUT OF
28 ANY FUNDS IN THE STATE TREASURY TO THE CREDIT OF THE DELINQUENT
29 AGENCY; TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPEAL OF THE TRANSFER OF, OR THE
30 FAILURE TO TRANSFER, FUNDS UNDER THIS SECTION; AND FOR RELATED
31 PURPOSES."

32 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE
33 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That the following
34 bills are hereby exempt from the timetable for consideration of
35 bills provided by Joint Rule No. 40, and that consent is hereby
36 given for further consideration of House Bill No. 1000, 2005
37 Regular Session, entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 27-103-125,
38 27-103-139 AND 27-103-211, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE
39 PERCENTAGE LIMITATION ON LEGISLATIVE APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE STATE

40 GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEARS 2006 AND 2007; TO AMEND SECTION
41 27-65-75, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DELAY UNTIL 2007 THE SALES
42 TAX DIVERSION THAT IS TO BE DEPOSITED INTO THE SPECIAL FUNDS
43 TRANSFER FUND; TO AMEND SECTION 4, CHAPTER 556, LAWS OF 2003, AS
44 AMENDED BY SECTION 10, CHAPTER 595, LAWS OF 2004, TO CONFORM TO
45 THE PRECEDING SECTION; TO AMEND SECTION 27-25-506, MISSISSIPPI
46 CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT BEGINNING WITH FISCAL YEAR 2006, ALL
47 AMOUNTS COLLECTED FROM CERTAIN TAX COLLECTIONS APPORTIONED TO THE
48 STATE FROM OIL AND GAS SEVERANCE TAXES SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE
49 STATE GENERAL FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."; Senate Bill No.
50 2845, 2005 Regular Session, entitled "AN ACT TO DIRECT THE STATE
51 FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER CERTAIN SPECIAL FUNDS INTO THE BUDGET
52 CONTINGENCY FUND DURING FISCAL YEAR 2005; TO AMEND SECTION 4,
53 CHAPTER 89, LAWS OF 2004, TO TRANSFER FUNDS IN THE FISCAL YEAR
54 2005 APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AMONG
55 VARIOUS CATEGORIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."; and House Bill No.
56 693, 2005 Regular Session, entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION
57 27-104-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF
58 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO ASSIST A STATE AGENCY IN COLLECTING
59 A FEE THAT ANOTHER STATE AGENCY HAS FAILED TO PAY TO IT; TO
60 AUTHORIZE THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER TO PAY THE CREDITOR AGENCY THE
61 AMOUNT OWED TO IT OUT OF ANY FUNDS IN THE STATE TREASURY TO THE
62 CREDIT OF THE DELINQUENT AGENCY; TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPEAL OF THE
63 TRANSFER OF, OR THE FAILURE TO TRANSFER, FUNDS UNDER THIS SECTION;
64 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."
