

REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

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MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1620: Appropriation; Board of Psychology.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of
8 Psychology, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the board
9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending
10 June 30, 2006..... \$ 103,668.00.

11 **SECTION 2.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
12 Mississippi State Board of Psychology shall maintain complete
13 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
14 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
15 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
16 Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
17 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be
18 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
19 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
20 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process.

21 **SECTION 3.** Of the funds provided herein, the sum of Three
22 Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-eight Dollars (\$3,668.00) is hereby
23 assessed on any non-federal special funds and shall be deposited
24 to the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301,
25 Mississippi Code of 1972, on or before October 1, 2005, for the

26 purpose of reimbursing the State of Mississippi for administrative
27 costs.

28 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
29 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
30 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
31 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
32 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
33 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

34 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
35 and after July 1, 2005.
