

House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2519

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section
7 49-19-408, Mississippi Code of 1972:

8 49-19-408. (1) A person may enter in or upon public or
9 private lands or waters, except buildings, while in the lawful
10 performance of forest inventory duties for the Mississippi
11 Institute for Forest Inventory without criminal liability for
12 trespass. The person shall make a good faith attempt to announce
13 and identify himself and his intentions before entering upon
14 private property, and an announcement of such intentions shall be
15 published in the legal notices in a newspaper having a general
16 circulation within the county at least twenty-one (21) days before
17 the date specified for entry upon private property.

18 (2) This section does not relieve the person from any civil
19 liability that otherwise is actionable at law or in equity, and
20 does not relieve the person from criminal liability for trespass
21 if the entry in or upon the property extends beyond the property
22 or area that is necessary to actually perform the forest inventory
23 duties.

24 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
25 and after its passage.
