House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2519

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section
- 7 49-19-408, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 8 $\underline{49-19-408}$. (1) A person may enter in or upon public or
- 9 private lands or waters, except buildings, while in the lawful
- 10 performance of forest inventory duties for the Mississippi
- 11 Institute for Forest Inventory without criminal liability for
- 12 trespass. The person shall make a good faith attempt to announce
- 13 and identify himself and his intentions before entering upon
- 14 private property, and an announcement of such intentions shall be
- 15 published in the legal notices in a newspaper having a general
- 16 circulation within the county at least twenty-one (21) days before
- 17 the date specified for entry upon private property.
- 18 (2) This section does not relieve the person from any civil
- 19 liability that otherwise is actionable at law or in equity, and
- 20 does not relieve the person from criminal liability for trespass
- 21 if the entry in or upon the property extends beyond the property
- 22 or area that is necessary to actually perform the forest inventory
- 23 duties.
- 24 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 25 and after its passage.
