AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

19	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State

Based on data provided by the 172 173 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 174 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 175 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 176 177 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 178 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2006 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 179 180 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 181 182 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2006 "Personal Services" 183 184 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 185 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 186 187 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 188 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 189 190 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 191 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 192 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 193 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 194 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 195

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive
Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer
between the various offices authorized herein both funds and
positions not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the receiving

appropriated level.

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205 office in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in 206 accordance with Section 27-104-17 (3), Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of 207 208 Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of 209 210 Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month prior to the effective date of the transfer. It is further the 211 212 intention of the Legislature that any transfers made under the 213 provisions of this paragraph shall be of an emergency nature and that in no case shall the transfers be made which substantially 214 215 alter the legislative intent for the various offices as set forth 216 in the original appropriations made under this act. SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 217 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 218 219 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds which are 220 received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services to provide funding for 221 222 construction grants and establishment grants for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006..... 223\$ 224 4,000,000.00. 225 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 226 Department of Rehabilitation Services shall maintain complete 227 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 228 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 229 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2005. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 230 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2007 shall be 231 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 232 233 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 234 provided during the Fiscal Year 2006 budget request process. SECTION 7. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or 235 236 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of 237 any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 238 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for

any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of

240 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

241 It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles

242 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply

243 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.

244 SECTION 8. Of the funds in Sections 1, 2 and 3, the

245 Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services through the

246 Office of Vocational Rehabilitation for the Blind is authorized to

247 expend an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars

248 (\$100,000.00) for the National Federation for the Blind (NFB)

249 Newsline service to allow blind and visually impaired persons to

250 access newspapers through toll-free telephone calls.

SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

257 **SECTION 10.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 258 and after July 1, 2005.
