4	WHEREAS, Lafayette Stribling, Mississippi Valley State
5	University's (MVSU) men's basketball coach, announced his
6	retirement plans on Monday, May 23, 2005, after 23 years at the
7	institution; and
8	WHEREAS, Coach Stribling, at 70 years of age, is not hanging
9	up his whistle as he becomes Tougaloo College men's basketball
10	coach, beginning his new job on July 1, the day after his Valley
11	contract expires; and
12	WHEREAS, in 22 seasons at MVSU, Stribling won a school-record
13	315 games and led the Delta Devils to four Southwestern Athletic
14	Conference (SWAC) regular-season championships, three SWAC
15	Tournament championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances;

17	WHEREAS, Coach Stribling secured his place in Valley and SWAC
18	lore by winning games with up-tempo basketball, becoming just as
19	well-known for the wide array of tailored suits, and establishing
20	himself as an institution at the university; and
21	WHEREAS, an alumnus of Mississippi Industrial College and
22	Mississippi State University, with additional certification
