1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE MISSISSIPPI
2 STATE "BULLDOGS" BASEBALL TEAM FOR WINNING THE SEC BASEBALL
3 TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP IN A HISTORIC TITLE GAME AGAINST THE OLE
4 MISS REBELS.

5 WHEREAS, the Mississippi State "Bulldogs" Baseball Team won
6 the SEC Baseball Tournament Championship in a historic title game
7 against the Ole Miss Rebels; and

8 WHEREAS, it was the first time the Bulldogs and Rebels had
9 met to decide a regular season or conference tournament
10 championship; and

11 WHEREAS, the MSU Bulldogs shut down what had been the most
12 prolific offense in the tournament by vanquishing the arch-rival
13 Rebels by a score of 4 to 1; and

14 WHEREAS, the MSU Bulldogs steamrolled through the tournament
15 going undefeated in tournament play; and

16 WHEREAS, the Bulldogs captured their sixth conference
17 tournament title in school history and the second in five years;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, Bulldog player, Jeff Butts, was named the
20 tournament's "Most Valuable Player"; and

21 WHEREAS, the "2005 Diamond Dogs" were ranked No. 19 in the
22 nation in the final baseball coaches poll; and

23 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this group
24 of talented student athletes who have brought honor to Mississippi
25 State University and the State of Mississippi:

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
27 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate the
28 Mississippi State "Bulldogs" Baseball Team and Coach Ron Polk for

29 winning the SEC Baseball Tournament Championship in a historic
30 title game against the Ole Miss Rebels and extend to them the best
