- SECTION 1. Section 25-3-34, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10

- appointive state and district official and employee, such official 13
- 14 and employee shall receive the award of an education benchmark as
- defined in State Personnel Board rules for the possession or 15
- attainment of any of the following: 16
- 17 (a) The Certified Public Manager designation;
- A job-related Ph.D (Doctor of Philosophy) degree 18
- 19 which is not required as a minimum qualification of the position;
- (c) A job related certification, licensure or 20
- 21 registration requiring the passage of an examination, which is not
- required as a minimum qualification of the position. 22
- 23 (2) No such official or employee may receive more than a
- total of three (3) eligible benchmarks, only one of which may be 24
- for a job related certification, licensure or registration. 25
