- SECTION 1. Section 73-63-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8

- 10 73-63-37. (1) The board shall establish, by rule,
- application fees which shall not exceed One Hundred Dollars 11
- (\$100.00) for application for registration and Fifty Dollars 12
- 13 (\$50.00) for application for enrollment.

- subsection (1) of this section, an applicant shall pay an 15
- examination fee before taking the applicable examination. 16
- 17 board shall set a reasonable examination fee for each examination
- administered by the board to defer the actual cost of the 18

- which shall not exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) annually for 21
