## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 90

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING PROFESSOR GEORGE COLVIN COCHRAN ON HIS OUTSTANDING CAREER ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN THE LEGAL FIELD AND AS A PROFESSOR OF LAW AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI SCHOOL OF LAW.
WHEREAS, Professor George C. Cochran has made many
outstanding contributions to the legal field as a practitioner of
law and as a professor for over 33 years in academia; and
WHEREAS, after receiving a bachelor of science degree from
North Carolina State College where he was class president in 1958
Professor Cochran served as First Lieutenant, Infantry, in the
United States Army; and
WHEREAS, Professor Cochran, after bravely serving his
country, received his juris doctor degree, with high honors, from
the University of North Carolina School of Law in 1964 where he
was Editor-in-Chief of North Carolina Law Review and a member of
the Order of the Coif; and
WHEREAS, after receiving his law degree, Professor Cochran
served as a law clerk for Associate Justice Stanley F. Reed and
Chief Justice Earl Warren of the United States Supreme Court, and
was an attorney for the President's Commission on the
Assassination of President Kennedy; and
WHEREAS, Professor Cochran joined the faculty of the
University of Mississippi School of Law in 1972 and became a full
professor within six years; and
WHEREAS, Professor Cochran teaches Supreme Court Practice,
Constitution Law I and II and Federal Jurisdiction at the

University of Mississippi and has been twice voted, in 1985 and

2000, by the law school student body as the top professor, which
