- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** It shall be unlawful for the judge of a county,
- 6 circuit or chancery court, judge of the Court of Appeals, or
- 7 justice of the Supreme Court who has received a personal monetary
- 8 gift in excess of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) from any litigant
- 9 appearing before that judge or justice to act in any capacity in a
- 10 case involving that litigant unless the gift has been disclosed to
- 11 all litigants in the matter. Violation of this section shall be a
- 12 felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department
- of Corrections not to exceed five (5) years.
- 14 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 15 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 16 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 17 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 18 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 19 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 20 extended.
- 21 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 23 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
