- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5
- SECTION 1. Section 49-27-61, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6

- 8 49-27-61. (1) (a) The commission shall charge One Dollar
- 9 (\$1.00) per cubic yard for any sand or gravel removed from
- 10 wetlands and Fifty Cents (50¢) per cubic yard for any other
- materials removed from coastal wetlands by a permittee or his 11
- 12 agent under the terms of any permit issued.
- (b) There shall be no charge levied by the commission 13
- for the removal of one hundred (100) cubic yards or less of any 14
- material removed from wetlands by a permittee or his agent under 15
- 16 the terms of any permit issued.
- 17 (c) The commission shall waive these charges on any
- project of a governmental agency or any project wherein 18
