- 62 Virtual Community College hosted and provided courses may 63 qualify on the basis of the prior year full-time equivalency of 64 Virtual Community College hours generated during the summer, fall 65 and spring semesters. Those semester credit hours being hosted 66 and provided by one institution shall receive funding at the weight of 1.0. 67
- Of the funds appropriated in the act for the aid and support 68 69 of the public community and junior colleges, funds up to Two 70 Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) are provided to be set aside as a mechanism to hold harmless those colleges that lose funding in the 71 72 fourth year of a five-year phase-in implementation period to a full-time equivalency (FTE) funding formula. 73
- 74 The Director of the State Board for Community and Junior 75 Colleges, or his designee, shall audit each public community and 76 junior college and shall determine who shall be counted in each 77 college and shall certify the number to the State Board for 78 Community and Junior Colleges.
- 79 If, pending determination of the enrollment of students at the public community and junior colleges entitled to participate 80 81 in this appropriation, as provided for in this subsection, the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges shall find and 82 determine that any such public or community junior college does 83 84 not have sufficient funds on hand for payment of the necessary expenses of its operation for the period commencing July 1, 2006, 85 86 until distribution of the funds appropriated hereby, then, in that event, the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges is 87 expressly authorized to make an advance to any such public 88 community or junior college or colleges not having sufficient 89 90 operating funds for such period from the funds appropriated 91 hereby; provided, however, that the amount of any such advance to any one public community or junior college shall not exceed
