1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
 2 PURPOSE OF THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF HOUSE BILL NO.
 3 1250, 2006 REGULAR SESSION, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN
 4 INCENTIVE FOR PERSONS, CORPORATIONS OR OTHER ENTITIES THAT MAKE
 5 CAPITAL INVESTMENTS TO LOCATE CERTAIN TOURISM-ORIENTED ENTERPRISES
 6 IN THIS STATE; TO CREATE THE TOURISM SALES TAX INCENTIVE FUND; TO
 7 AUTHORIZE INCENTIVE PAYMENTS FROM SUCH FUND TO PERSONS,
 8 CORPORATIONS OR OTHER ENTITIES THAT MAKE CAPITAL INVESTMENTS TO
 9 LOCATE CERTAIN TOURISM-ORIENTED ENTERPRISES IN THIS STATE; TO
 10 AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO DEVELOP A
 11 PROGRAM TO ADMINISTER THE TOURISM INCENTIVE PROGRAM AUTHORIZED BY
 12 THIS ACT; TO CREATE THE TOURISM INCENTIVE PROGRAM; TO AMEND
 13 SECTION 27-65-75, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM TO THE
 14 PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES." AND SUSPENDING
 15 THE DEADLINES FOR THE PURPOSE OF REQUESTING THE DRAFTING,
 16 INTRODUCTION, CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF A BILL ENTITLED "AN ACT
 17 TO AMEND SECTION 65-4-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE BY
 18 \$22,000,000.00 THE AMOUNT OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS THAT MAY BE
 19 ISSUED UNDER THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT HIGHWAY ACT; AND FOR RELATED
 20 PURPOSES."

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE
 22 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That the following
 23 bill is hereby exempt from the timetable for consideration of
 24 bills provided by Joint Rule No. 40, and that consent is hereby
 25 given for further consideration of House Bill No. 1250, 2006
 26 Regular Session, entitled "AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN INCENTIVE FOR
 27 PERSONS, CORPORATIONS OR OTHER ENTITIES THAT MAKE CAPITAL
 28 INVESTMENTS TO LOCATE CERTAIN TOURISM-ORIENTED ENTERPRISES IN THIS
 29 STATE; TO CREATE THE TOURISM SALES TAX INCENTIVE FUND; TO
 30 AUTHORIZE INCENTIVE PAYMENTS FROM SUCH FUND TO PERSONS,
 31 CORPORATIONS OR OTHER ENTITIES THAT MAKE CAPITAL INVESTMENTS TO
 32 LOCATE CERTAIN TOURISM-ORIENTED ENTERPRISES IN THIS STATE; TO
 33 AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO DEVELOP A
 34 PROGRAM TO ADMINISTER THE TOURISM INCENTIVE PROGRAM AUTHORIZED BY
 35 THIS ACT; TO CREATE THE TOURISM INCENTIVE PROGRAM; TO AMEND

36 SECTION 27-65-75, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM TO THE
37 PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint Rules of the Senate
39 and the House are hereby suspended for the purpose of requesting
40 the drafting, introduction, consideration and passage, regardless
41 of any deadlines imposed by said rules, of a bill entitled "AN ACT
42 TO AMEND SECTION 65-4-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE BY
43 \$22,000,000.00 THE AMOUNT OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS THAT MAY BE
44 ISSUED UNDER THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT HIGHWAY ACT; AND FOR RELATED
45 PURPOSES."
