House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2983

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 7 SECTION 1. Section 67-5-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, as
- amended by Senate Bill No. 2454, 2006 Regular Session, is amended 8
- 9 as follows:
- (1) Upon every producer holding a permit for the 10 67-5-13.
- production of native wine, there is * * * levied and imposed for 11
- 12 each location for the privilege of engaging and continuing in this
- 13 state in the production of native wine an annual privilege license
- tax in an amount equal to Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each ten 14
- 15 thousand (10,000) gallons, or any part thereof, of native wine
- produced by the winery. 16
- There is * * * levied and assessed an excise tax upon 17
- 18 each case of native wine sold by a producer to any source to be
- 19 collected from the producer in the amount provided for in Section
- 20 27-71-7 * * *. However, native wine produced in Mississippi for
- 21 export and sale without this state and native wine produced in
- Mississippi and sold to the commission shall not be subject to the 22
- excise tax, nor shall the tax accrue or be collected on native 23
- 24 wines dispensed, as free samples in quantities of not more than
- six (6) ounces, in the tasting room of a native winery. 25
- 26 The privilege tax imposed by subsection (1) of this
- 27 section shall be collected in the same manner as presently
- provided by law for the collection of other alcoholic beverages. 28
- 29 The excise tax imposed by subsection (2) of this section shall be
- reported monthly by the producer to the commission on all sales 30
- 31 made in Mississippi to consumers at the location of the native
- winery or its immediate vicinity, along with a statement of 32

- gallonage produced during that month, and the producer shall remit 33
- 34 the tax due and owing with each report. The producer shall also
- include in the report a statement of gallonage sold and exported 35
- 36 for sale outside this state.
- (4) All taxes levied by and collected under this section 37
- 38 shall be deposited in the General Fund.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 39
- and after July 1, 2006. 40

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 67-5-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, AS AMENDED BY SENATE BILL NO. 2454, 2006 REGULAR SESSION, TO PROVIDE THAT PRODUCERS OF NATIVE WINE SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO PAY AN 2

EXCISE TAX ON NATIVE WINE THEY SELL TO THE STATE TAX COMMISSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
