

House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3049

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Massage Therapy Fund,
8 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi State
9 Board of Massage Therapy for the fiscal year beginning
10 July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007.....
11 \$ 103,861.00.

12 **SECTION 2.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
13 Board of Massage Therapy shall maintain complete accounting and
14 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
15 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
16 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
17 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
18 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to
19 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
20 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
21 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

22 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
23 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
24 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
25 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
26 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
27 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
28 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
29 made without competitive bids.

30 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
31 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
32 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
33 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
34 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
35 in the manner provided by law.

36 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
37 and after July 1, 2006.
