31 For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are 32 provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an 33 34 amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on 35 July 1, 2006. 36 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 39 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 40 41 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42 43 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 44 45 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 46 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 47 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 48 49 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 50 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 51 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 52 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 53 54 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 55 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 56 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 57 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 58 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 60 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 61 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 62 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 63

approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

- 65 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 66 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 67
- 68 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 69
- act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 70
- 71 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that with
- 72 the funds appropriated in Section 1 and authorized for expenditure
- 73 in Section 2, the Mississippi Workers' Compensation Commission
- shall enter into a contract with the industrial private sector for 74
- 75 the purpose of implementing a safety education and training
- 76 program.
- 77 SECTION 4. With the funds provided herein, it is the intent
- 78 of the Legislature that the Workers' Compensation Commission may
- 79 transfer a sum or sums not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 80 (\$200,000.00) from the Administrative Expense Fund to the Second
- 81 Injury Fund.
- 82 SECTION 5. With the funds provided herein, it is the intent
- 83 of the Legislature that the Workers' Compensation Commission may
- transfer a sum or sums not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand 84
- Dollars (\$150,000.00) from the Administrative Expense Fund to the 85
- 86 Insurance Integrity Enforcement Bureau within the Office of the
- 87 Attorney General.
- 88 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 89 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 90
- 91 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 92
- 93 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 94 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- made without competitive bids. 95
- 96 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 97 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 98 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 99 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

- 100 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 101 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 102
- 103 and after July 1, 2006.
